

# Christian Life wins sectional track title

First-place finishes from Jennier Sio and Holly Wiersema led Christian Life to the Class A sectional team title at Rockford Christian Friday.

Sio placed first in the long jump (16-06) and the triple jump (36-0), while Wiersema won the pole vault (10-0) and also qualified for state in the 100-meter hurdles and the high jump.

The Eagles edged second-place Genoa-Kingston 108-95, and host team Rockford Christian was third with a score of 67.

State-qualifying individuals from Rockford Christian included **Molly Ellis**, who won the 100-meter dash (12.40) and was second in the 400 dash (59.10), and **Courtney McKibben**, who won the 100 hurdles (15.30) and the 300 hurdles (49.80).

The Eagles and Royals both advanced in the 400-meter relay, Genoa-Kingston and Christian Life advanced in the 800 relay, and **Rockford Christian won the 1,600 relay**.

Local qualifiers who advanced by surpassing the state standards included Genoa-Kingston's Sam McClay in the 200 dash (26.40) and the pole vault (9-03); Haley Camacho and Lauren Strohmaier advanced for the Cogs in the high jump; North Boone's Kelly Boyce and Genoa-Kingston's Richelle Johnson qualified in the triple jump; and Christian Life's Tailyr Negri qualified in the pole vault.

## **Erie Sectional**

Sterling Newman and Amboy each qualified in three events at Friday's Erie Sectional. Newman freshman Sarah Kapp was third in the long jump (16-04), Newman's 3,200-meter relay team also placed third and advanced with a 10:22.6, and 800-meter runner Amanda Trancoso finished second with a 2:27.8.

Alyssa Hopps led Amboy with first-place finishes in the shot put (37-09.5) and discus throw (116-09). Amboy also advanced in the 3,200 relay with a 10:17.8.

Manlius Bureau Valley won the meet.
